Department of Education* case (CA v. ED) on April 4, 2025 (1:25-cv-10548) (D. Mass.) or the stay of the Preliminary Injunction (PI) ordered by the 4th Circuit Court of Appeals (No. 25-1281) in the *Amer. Assoc. of Colleges et al. v. McMahon, et al.* case (AACTE v. McMahon) on April 10, 2025 (1:25-cv-00702-JRR) (D. Md).

Please refer to your grant termination letter for further details as your grant has now reentered a termination (closeout) status. Therefore, no further expenditures under this grant are authorized for obligations that incurred on or after the dates of these respective court decisions. However, as specified in your termination letter, grantees may submit route pay requests for obligations incurred prior to the original grant termination date or for obligations that were incurred during the time that either the TRO in *California v.
